## **Unit 81: PURPOSE & USE**

Here are some ways to show why you did something, why something exists, or what its use is.

## 1 Purpose

to + BASE VERB
 We put on lots of clothes to keep warm.
 You have to study hard to be a doctor.

**NOTICE:** We also use **in order to** the same way.

**b** so that CLAUSE

We put on lots of clothes

I put it by the door

I took a taxi

so that we wouldn't get cold.

so that I wouldn't forget it.

so that I'd arrive early.

**C** because CLAUSE with want

I put it by the door **because** I **didn't want to** forget it.

I took a taxi **because** I **wanted to** arrive early.

**NOTICE:** We can give the purpose at the beginning of the sentence if we want to. For example:

To be a doctor, you have to study hard.

Because I wanted to arrive early, I took a taxi.

## 2 Use

With for

The seats by the door are **for** the use of old people.

A pen is **for** writing with.

What did you do that **for**?

A barometer is a thing **for** measuring air pressure.

**NOTICE:** If there is a verb after **for**, it is the **–ing** form.
